5. All Faculties of the department participated in FDP on PO, PSO, CO attainment on 18<sup>th</sup> November 2017, RRJT, Bengaluru.

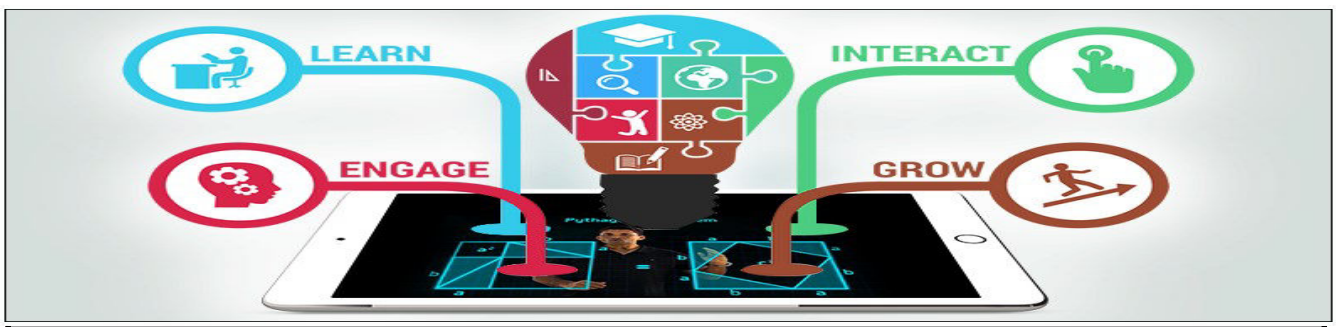

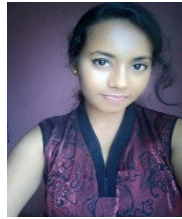

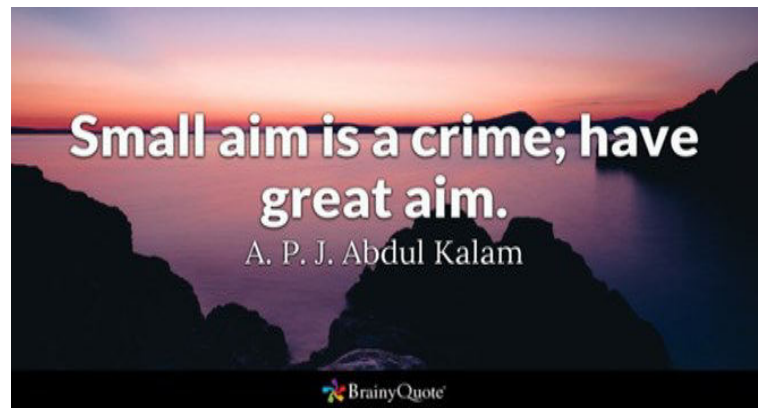

## Best open source alternatives for expensive applications:

### Use Linux distro instead of Windows:

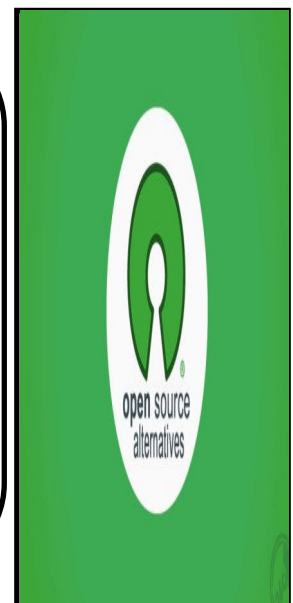
1. **Bluefish** : **Category:** Web Site Creation Tools —> offers a very fast WYSIWYG HTML editor that doesn't use a lot of system resources. Aimed at coders more than designers, it also includes support for a number of other programming languages.

**Replaces:** Adobe Dreamweaver

**Supported OS:** Windows, OS X and Linux

2. **PDFCreator** : **Category:** PDF Tools —> creates a PDF file from an application that can print. It also includes the digital signature and encryption capabilities, but it lacks some of Acrobat's form creating capabilities.

**Replaces:** Adobe Acrobat (\$381.65) **Supported OS:** Windows, OS X and Linux

Android is a mobile operating system developed by Google, based on a modified version of the Linux kernel and other open source software and designed primarily for touchscreen mobile devices such as smartphones and tablets

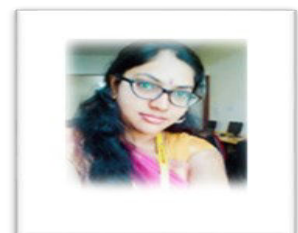
